



The Chilliwack Arts & Cultural Centre Society operates the City of Chilliwack's Chilliwack Cultural Centre through an arms length management contract. The Centre houses the HUB International Theatre, the Rotary Hall Studio Theatre, O'Connor Group Art Gallery, the Chilliwack Community Arts Council Clay and Ceramics Studio, The Lidstone and Co. Electronic Arts Studio, The Lock's Pharmacy Children's Performance Studio, Painting and Drawing Studio, Crafting Studio, Choral Studio, three performance studios, and 18 music instruction studios. The Centre is a partnership between the City of Chilliwack, the Chilliwack Arts & Cultural Centre Society, the Chilliwack Academy of Music, the Chilliwack Player's Guild, the Chilliwack Visual Artists' Association, the Chilliwack School of Performing Arts, the Chilliwack Symphony Orchestra and Chorus, and the Chilliwack Lion's Club Music and Dance Festival.

As the Centre's Artistic and Managing Director I present a series of 40+ shows and fundraising events since The Centre's opening in 2010. Each year this programming includes the work of professional magicians and illusionists. Over these years we have included the work of 16 different magicians on our stages.

I have presented Vitaly's show An Evening of Wonders five times at the Chilliwack Cultural Centre. As someone who has presented and seen many magic and illusion shows, I can say that Vitaly's show is completely unique and original and I have never seen anything else like it. Our audiences have been entranced by this fine performer as he shatters expectations of what stage magic entails.
